Starting



- Special attention to the gender gap and the promotion of training in demographic declined areas



- Recovery Plan , Transformation and Resilience
- Policy Lever VII: education and knowledge , lifelong learning and skills development.



- Component 19 National Skills Digital Plan
- Investment 3 Competencies related to employment.



- Goal : Strengthen digital skills of the entire population, from school digitalization to university, through qualification at work (upskilling and reskilling).



Challenges



- 80% of the population receiving basic digital skills training, **half** of them should be **women**
- At least 25 % of the business volume of SMEs, by 2025, belong to **electronic commerce**.

Performance



- **VET and non-formal training in digital skills** demanded by the productive area with the aim of improving **future employability** and promoting **digital entrepreneurship** (in particular, strengthening the extension of technology-based start-ups) of **women unemployed**, living in **rural areas or small municipalities**.
